About Harrow Hengqin

Harrow LiDe School Hengqin is the first and only bilingual school in GBA to offer full K-12 education to both day and boarding students under the Harrow Family Brand. 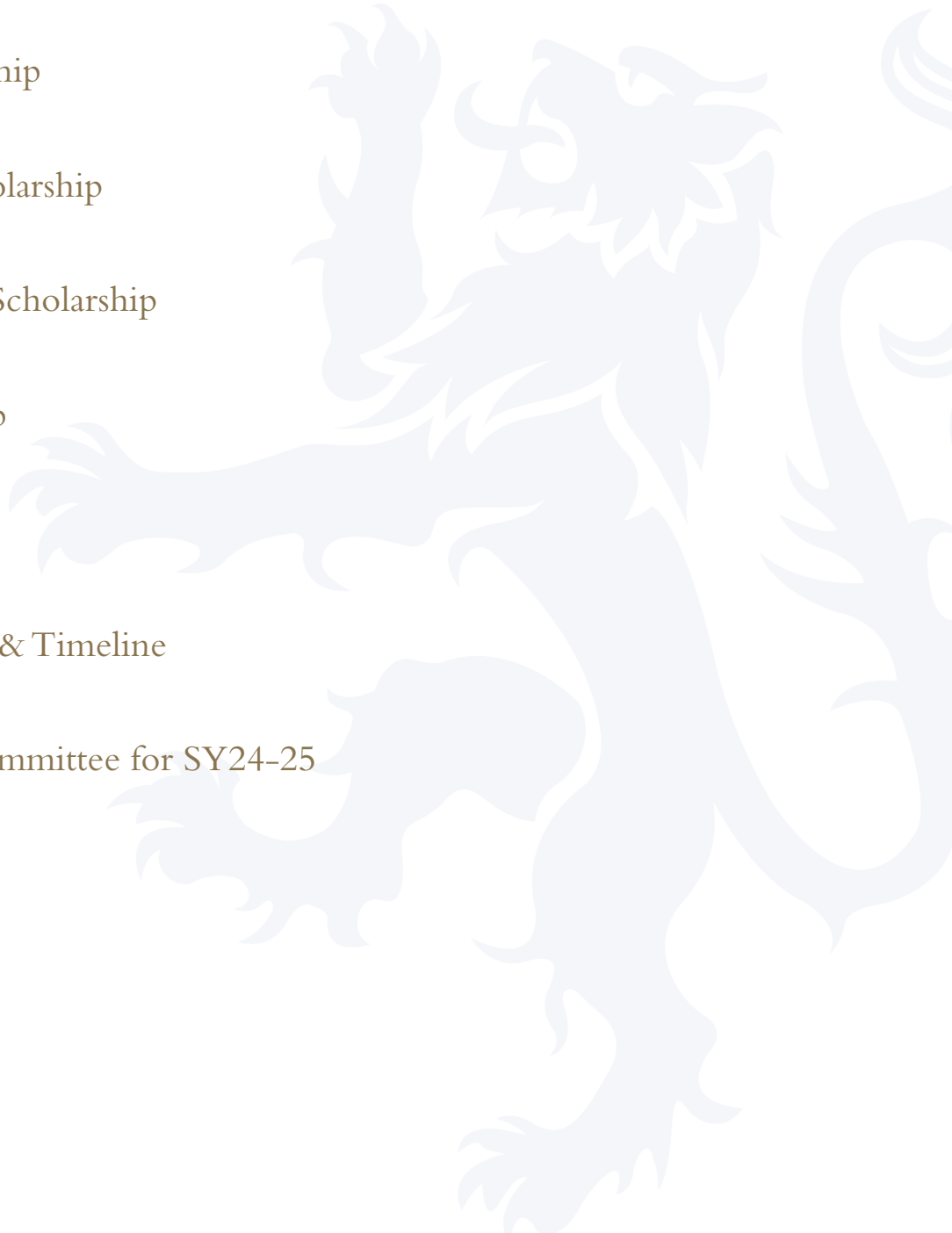

As one of the most significant Harrow traditions, scholarships have been created and used to encourage academic excellence and to promote holistic education at Harrow schools.

Through our scholarship program, we aim to encourage our pupils at Harrow Hengqin to achieve outstanding academic results and develop the motivation, skills and determination to make a positive difference to the world in which they live. Pupils will gain experience of a variety of forms of leadership: leading from the front; being an effective team player; and acting as a positive role model.

For School Year 2024-2025, Harrow Hengqin will be offering 6 scholarships to encourage excellence in academics, literature, arts and sports, leadership and services, and most importantly holistic development. 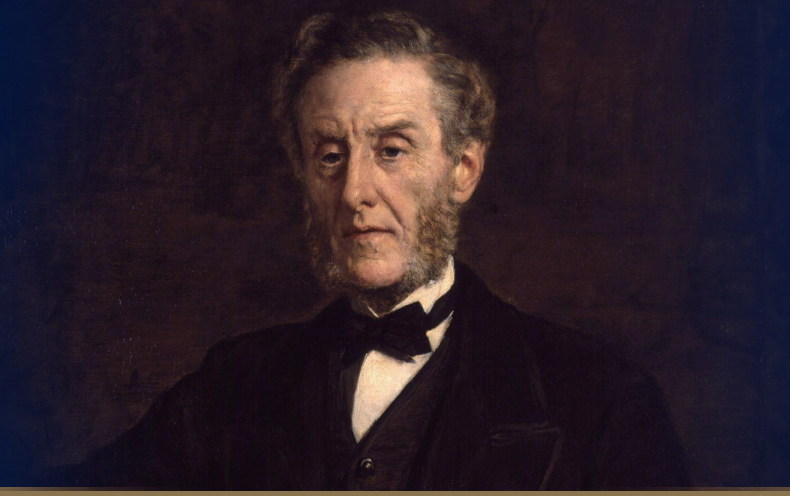

The Shaftesbury Scholarship

About the Scholarship

The Shaftesbury Scholarship is a one-year 10% scholarship available for current and deposited students for SY 24-25 entry at Harrow Hengqin for current Grade 3 to Grade 10 students. The scholar should demonstrate true Harrovian values and excel in holistic development. They need to be able to showcase what makes a true Harrovian.

The award is named after Lord Shaftesbury (1801-1885), Anthony Ashley Cooper, 7th Earl of Shaftesbury who is a famous Harrow alumnus. Shaftesbury was known as the Reforming Lord Shaftesbury and the Poor Man's Earl, because many of the reforms he championed helped the poor and the working class of Victorian Britain.

About the Scholarship

The Churchill Scholarship is a one-year 20% scholarship available for current students and deposited students for SY24-25 entry at AISL Harrow Hengqin from current Grade 3 to Grade 10. The scholar should demonstrate excellent academic achievements and have a holistic development with strong bilingual capabilities. The scholar should be an exemplary Harrow student who acts upon the Harrow values.

The award is named after Sir Winston Churchill (1874-1965) – the most famous and influential British Prime Minister in history and the man named Greatest Briton of all Time by the British public.

- ❖ Has a passion and enthusiasm for learning and improving.

- ❖ Demonstrate Harrow Values through actions.



The Byron Scholarship

About the Scholarship

The Byron Scholarship is a one-year 20% scholarship available for current students and deposited students for SY24-25 entry at AISL Harrow Hengqin from current Grade 5 to Grade 10. The scholar must demonstrate exceptional achievement in one of the 3 areas (Literature, Art, Sports) and also have very good performance in academic learning. Applicants will need to hold awards in said areas at the national or international level, and will continue to excel in that area.

The award is named after Lord George Gordon Byron (1788-1824) – a leading figure in the Romantic Movement. He is a world-renowned British poet and has been regarded as among the greatest of English poets of all time.

What we look for:

- ❖ Demonstrates an exceptional ability or potential in Literature, Art or Sport.
- ❖ Has obtained recognised national or international awards in one of the three area in the past 2 years.
- ❖ Displays an enthusiasm and dedication that surpasses regular expectations.
- ❖ Has a passion and enthusiasm for learning and improving.
- ❖ Makes the most of opportunities for leadership in Literature, Art or Sport.
- ❖ Demonstrate Harrow Values through actions.



The John Lyon Scholarship

About the Scholarship

The John Lyon Scholarship is a one-year 30% scholarship available to an existing or deposited student who will enter Grade 11 in SY 24-25. The scholar should have exceptional academic performance in either the British pathway or CNC pathway, be a valid representation of Harrow Values and be able to clearly demonstrate leadership skills. The scholar should be aiming to attend a most prestigious university in their future.

The award is named after John Lyon (1514-1592) – the founder of Harrow School. Recipients of this scholarship can continue to apply for a second year.

- ❖ Demonstrates advanced thinking skills, is determined in the face of complex tasks, thinks independently and creatively.
- ❖ Has a passion and enthusiasm for learning and improving.
- ❖ Displays an enthusiasm and dedication beyond the classroom.
- ❖ Makes the most of opportunities for leadership in their field of interest.
- ❖ Aspires to apply to the top world universities in their field of interest.
- ❖ Demonstrate Harrow Values through actions.



The Head Master's Scholarship

About the Scholarship

The Head Master's Scholarship is a one-year half scholarship available for current students and deposited students for SY24-25 entry at AISL Harrow Hengqin from current Grade 5 to Grade 10. The scholar should demonstrate excellent academic performance, while also having a clear exhibition of holistic growth. The scholar should be a good representation of Harrow Values. The student who receives this scholarship will be approved by the Head Master as an exemplary Harrovian.

The award is a traditional scholarship through all Harrow family schools, of which the Head Master has the authority to nominate excellent and exemplary Harrow students.

- ❖ Aspires to apply to the top universities in their field of interest.

The Hill Scholarship

About the Scholarship

The Hill Scholarship is a one year 50% boarding fee reduction for current boarding students Grade 4 to Grade 10 for SY24-25. The scholar should have been a boarding student for a minimum of one year. They should demonstrate excellent holistic development and understand what an “excellent” boarding student is. They should be proactive in their offering to the boarding community. The scholar should be an exemplary Harrovian who upholds the Harrow Values.

The award is named after The Hill on which Harrow London sits. The school is fondly known in the UK as “Harrow on the Hill”.

What we look for:

- ❖ Must have a minimum of one year boarding experience at Harrow Hengqin.
- ❖ Demonstrates the skills needed to be an excellent boarding student
- ❖ Has shown leadership in the boarding house while a boarding student
- ❖ Shows passion and enthusiasm for boarding
- ❖ Is an exceptional role model for their peers in the boarding community.

How to Apply

Harrow Hengqin scholarships for SY24-25 will be opened for application from 25th March and will ONLY be available for existing students and accepted students*. The deadline for applications is 5th May. Applicants should meet all expected criteria and be able to demonstrate valid proof of achievements.

To apply, applicants should first download and fill in the Scholarship Application Form from:

with a complete set of supporting documents including the following:

1. Personal Statement written by the student (within 800 words)
2. A PowerPoint Presentation demonstrating the students achievements (within 12 slides)
3. Copies of awards and certificates (if any)
4. The Byron Scholarship applicants should be able to demonstrate their plan to further their achievements in a set area.
5. Transcripts from last school year for non-Harrow students.
6. One recommendation letter from one teacher for non-Harrow students.

Once an applicant has been shortlisted as a potential scholar, he/she will be invited to join the scholarship test and panel interview with the Scholarship Committee. The result of the test and interview will eventually decide the scholarship winners.

For each panel interview, at least 3 members of the committee shall participate to validate the judging result. The Head Master will be a standing member for the panel for the Head Master Scholarship and the John Lyon Scholarship.

FAQ

Who can apply?

Scholarships are available to both current students and accepted students for SY23-24. Each scholarship will be only for a set grade level. Please check the brochure carefully to see which Scholarships you can apply for.

What does a Scholarship include?

Scholars are recognised by awarding a fee remission of up to 50% and providing a pathway for Scholars to follow. The remission of the fee will only apply to the annual tuition of School Year 2024-2025. The remissions does not apply to school bus, uniform, boarding (except the HILL scholarship), catering, paid CCA/SCA etc.

Is there a Scholarship assessment fee?

The scholarship assessment is free.

Can my child apply for more than one Scholarship?

It is possible to apply for TWO different scholarships. Successful pupils may ONLY be awarded ONE scholarship at their choices.

How much funding will I receive?

Successful Scholarship candidates will receive up to 50% of their annual School fees. The exact amount is at the discretion of the Head Master and the Scholarship Committee.

FAQ

How long will the Awards last?

Scholarships are created and awarded annually. Theoretically, a scholarship could last for the duration of your child's time at the school, subject to consistent performance and provided conditions are met.

Is the information in my application confidential?

All information disclosed in the Scholarship application form is treated as confidential and is only shared with the relevant department(s).

Are Scholarships available to pupils considering boarding?

Scholarships are available to both Day pupils and Boarders.

What do I need to supply with my Scholarship application?

Please supply all references for your chosen scholarships along with your scholarship application form. Applicants for Byron Scholarship are encouraged to supply a digital portfolio if any.

Am I guaranteed a scholarship if I meet all the academic criteria?

The scholarship application will be evaluated by the Scholarship Committee based on a wide range of criteria, including academic, leadership and Harrow Values etc. It is desirable if you can meet all the academic criteria, but academic criteria alone will not guarantee the scholarship.
